The Civilian Review and Complaints Commission (the Commission) is writing to acknowledge receipt of additional information regarding your public complaint. The following information has been forwarded to the RCMP on your behalf:

THE FOLLOWING WAS RECEIVED BY THE COMMISSION VIA ONLINE COMPLAINT FORM:

Children Threatened. Disabled woman threatened. Directed and recorded threats from Police. As a Canadian citizen I am DEMNDING a senior official CONTACT ME ASAP. Children, Disabled people and civilians ware threatened and terrorized., And you send me to Musquodoboit Harbour who works with Sheet Harbor... think about how negligent that is... the officer wouldn't even tell me who i report this too.... he said it isn't him.... if it isn't Police or RCMP then who is it!?

The officer said he couldn't move forward unless i physically come in.... ANY LAWYER WOULD SAY NO.... so why is that Officer doing that why can't he tell me who I report these issues too? We all know why.

Do you realize the Chief of Police in Halifax seems to have resigned in response to evidence and videos submitted and this guy is saying he doesn't know who looks into this...? Scott JEWERS confirmed that his additional details were intended to be additional general information for file 2023-1031. Scott JEWERS is frustrated that the public complaint investigator is only able to investigate the RCMP members' misconduct and not the incident itself that he reported. Scott JEWERS said he has reached out to the police 15 times in an attempt to have the initial incident investigated but no members will
